

## 2023 School-Based Traineeship Opportunities

A number of paid School-Based Traineeship opportunities are available to Year 10 to 12 students (aged 15+ years) in East Gippsland Schools in 2023.

Our paid traineeships provide students with an opportunity to receive practical on-the-job skills and work experience whilst gaining a Certificate II in Conservation & Ecosystem Management alongside regular school studies.

Envite Environment and the Department of Energy, Environment & Climate Action (Formerly DELWP) are working with partners Westvic Staffing Solutions and East Gippsland Secondary Schools to provide these opportunities for young people in the region.

Traineeships with Envite are proudly funded by the East Gippsland Community Foundation.

### How long does a Traineeship go for?

Traineeships will run for 40 weeks between January and December 2023. As a trainee, you will work for 1 day (7.6 hours) per week (or equivalent) with Envite or DEECA to deliver environmental and community projects in your local area. This paid work experience will be undertaken in addition to your normal school studies.

### Why be a Trainee?

As a trainee, you will have the opportunity to obtain a Certificate II in Conservation & Ecosystem Management. You will complete the required course work as part of your school studies. Trainees commit to participating in structured training, assessments and complete the required coursework to achieve the qualification. Specific modules have been selected to align with your work experience with Envite and DEECA and to maximise your employability after completing your traineeship.

### How to Apply:

1. Register your interest in a School-Based Traineeship with your school careers teacher
2. Complete the SBAT application form
  - a) Your name, age and contact details
  - b) Why do you want to do a Certificate II in Conservation & Ecosystem Management Traineeship?
  - c) Why will you be a great Trainee?
3. Your careers teacher will assist you to submit your application.
